It is a snapshot of their activity on 1 November 2024 and aims to reflect settled activity and not merely the first destination after leaving school which may only be a temporary one.

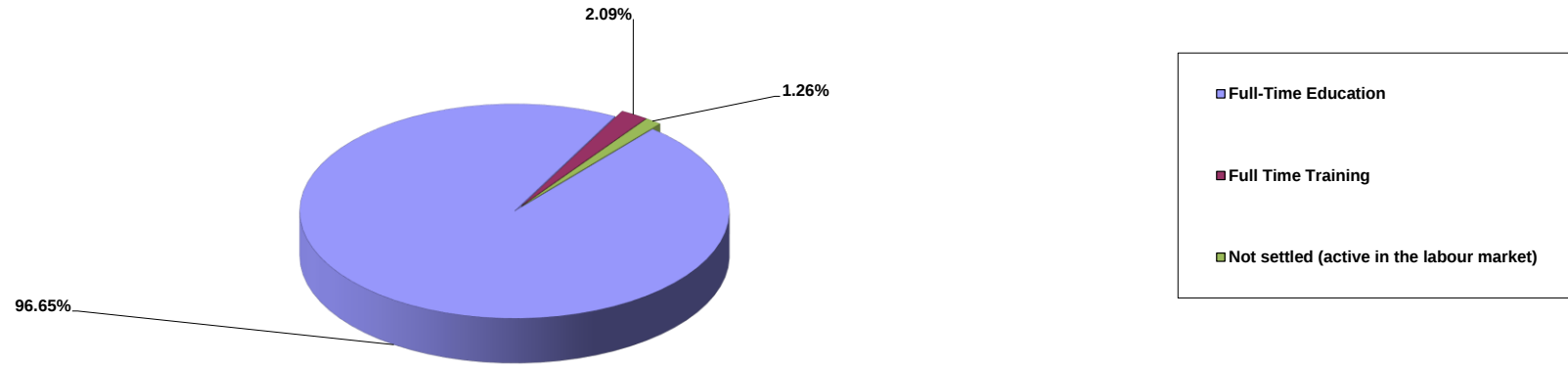
The information in this report was obtained by contacting students leaving Year 11 during the summer and autumn 2024.

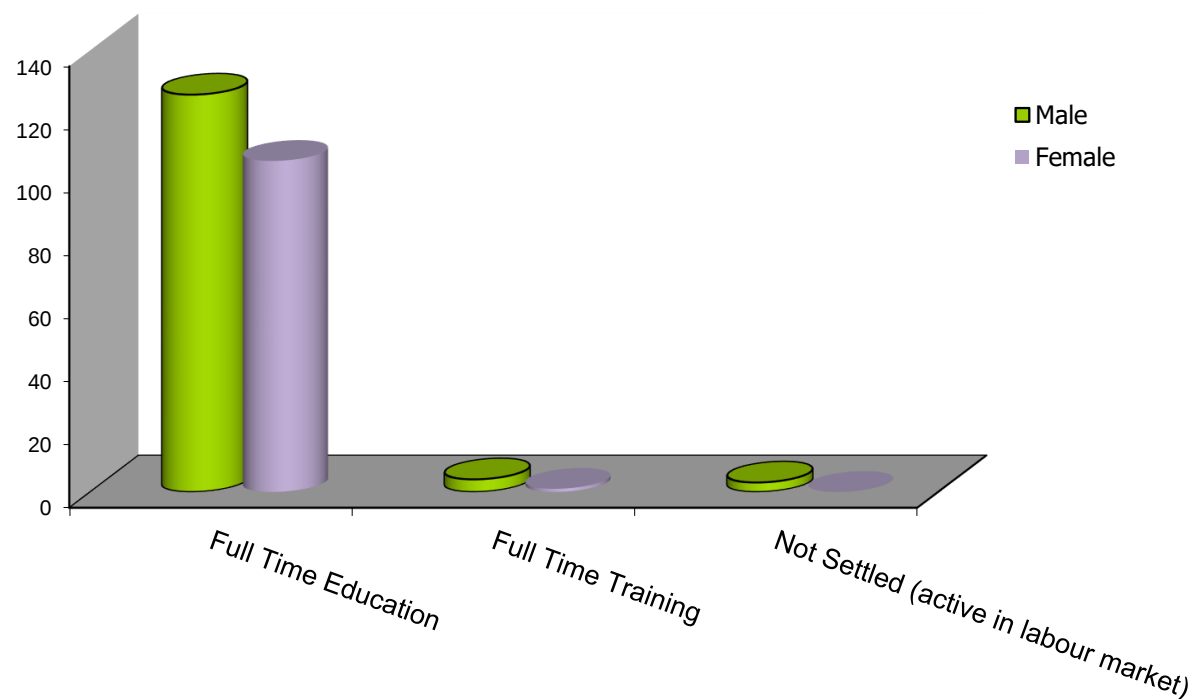

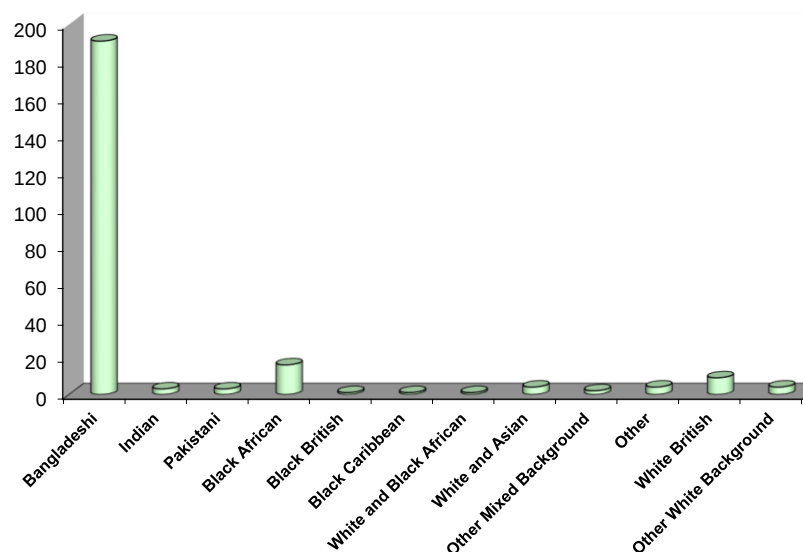

Gender Division of Year 11 Destinations - 2024

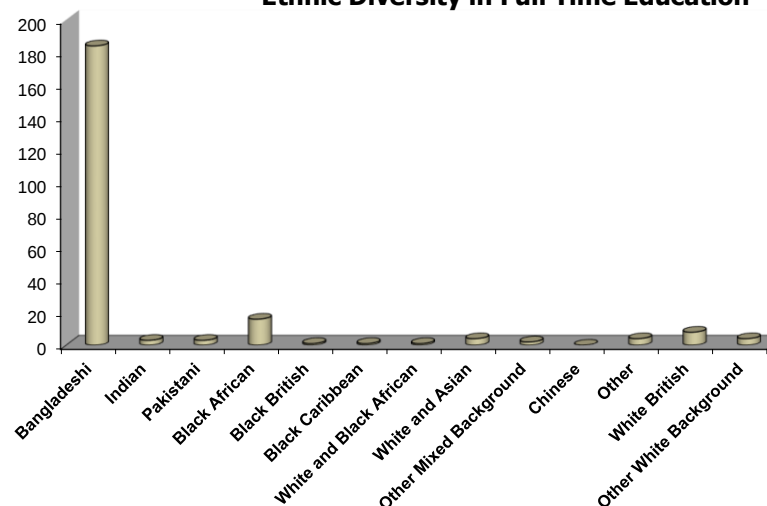
