Spring 2 (5 weeks)	<u>Me and My Community- Case Study 1: The Hillsborough Disaster and Liverpool FC, 1989</u> 1. What happened at Hillsborough? 2. Impact of Hillsborough on public safety, justice, and institutional responsibility/accountability 3. 'You'll never Walk Alone'- The importance of social cohesion, human rights and activism.
Summer 1 (6 weeks)	<u>Me and My Community- Case Study 2: London Riots, 2011</u> 1. What caused the Riots and what was the role of young people in the riots and the media portrayal of them? 2. Responses from authorities and community-led initiatives to promote rebuilding, reconciliation and change 3. Conflict/Riots in the future- how could I respond to social tension?
Summer 2 (8 weeks)	<u>Me and My Community- Case Study 3: Grenfell Tower Tragedy, West London 2017</u> 1. What caused the Grenfell Tower Fire? 2. Issues of government responsibility and social inequality. 3. The role of community and activism in responding to crises. 4. <u>Final Reflection</u>: Me and My Community in the future: How will I take social responsibility in my community?
