SPW6 Devices Policy

SPW is a no-mobile phone or wearable devices school. This means that in the main school building of the school you are not permitted to have your mobile phone or headphones/wireless earphones visible **at any time**, including break and lunchtime. If you are seen with these items by any member of staff, **it will be immediately confiscated**. Phones can only be returned to students at the end of the school day.

We appreciate that sixth form students may need access to their devices during study periods and/or break and lunchtime for purposes of schoolwork, therefore you are permitted to use these within the



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sixth form area in the main school building. Any staff member still reserves the right to confiscate items if they are not being used appropriately.
